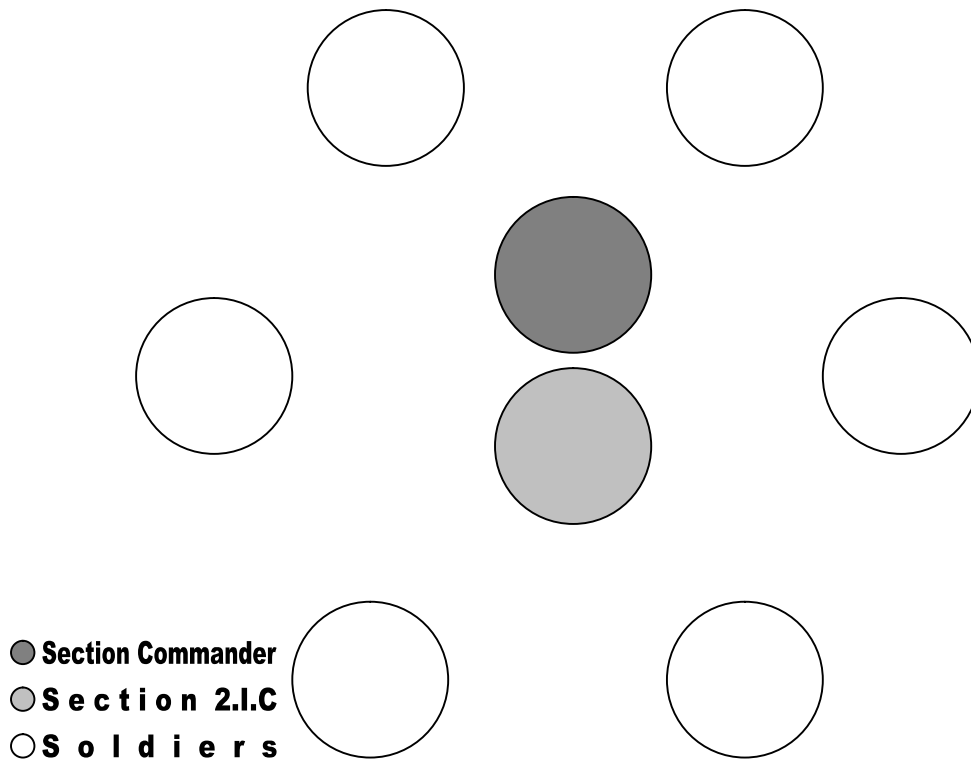


All Round Defence



All Round Defence is used when the Section Commander and 2.I.C need to communicate, and make decisions about the patrol. The six remaining soldiers in the fire team create a perimeter around them and keep an eye out for enemy with their weapons in the ready position.

All Round Defence can also be used in a casualty scenario. The soldiers form All Round Defence around the casualty so that the medic can treat them as safely as possible in a hostile area and if need be extract them.

By forming a circle it gives the section a full 360 degrees of view, and arch of fire.

The hand signal for this is rotating your hand around the top of your head and pointing to wear you want it to be done.
